

A New Castle, New Hampshire, Bibliography.

This bibliography lists non-fiction books and pamphlets that are focused on New Castle, NH, including items both commercially published and with limited or private publication, but excluding unpublished manuscripts and documents. This is supplemented by a short list of related works that include New Castle but are more general in subject matter.

A special case is the “Maxam Book,” the unpublished work of Ken Maxam, Fred White, and Gene Morrill that is a major resource for New Castle history:

Maxam, Kenneth E. [circa 1980]. *History of New Castle*. With major contributions by Fred White and Gene Morrill. Unpublished. 42 chapters, in 4 ring binders, pages not consecutively numbered. Available for reference at the New Castle (NH) Historical Society.

In the primary group, only three titles (Albee, Baker, Robinson) are the product of general-purpose book publishers. All the other titles were printed for special audiences and in many cases privately printed. Most of the titles are in the Historical Society collection.
